23. No Peeky Nine Patch Cow (Black and White setting): Yes, I know we've done so many no peekies, but this is a great way to set those little nine patches. To start, cut a zillion 2 1/2 inch squares. We put them all in a bag, mix them up, and pull them out by the handful and sew them into the nine patches. When you have enough, we assemble them into a dynamic on point setting. Some call this a free quilt because you are using scraps for the main part of it. You only need to add the setting fabric to make a beautiful top. You can use black and white like the sample or pick any other 2 colours. High contrast works great. . Sample will be 59.5 x 75.5 before borders and uses almost 600 2.5 inch squares. You must have your squares cut prior

to the class. Great fun for everyone.


